

Druridge Bay Country Park

Map Notes

Scale: 1,7,500 with 2.5m contours

A4 printed on waterproof paper with course and control descriptions.

Courses White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green and Short Green use a single piece map as normal.

Courses Green, Blue and Brown use a map composed of two pieces side by side to cover the whole of a long area. The course starts on one piece and then transfers to the other with the change control shown on both. Control descriptions show a map change. Both parts are on the same side of the paper.

In addition to some minor updates the map has been updated to the latest standard ISOM2017. The major differences are that some lines are slightly thicker and, hence, more prominent. In the main these are the tracks and paths which stand out more than in the previous standard.

The new standard also has an alternative vegetation boundary symbol of a green dashed line as well as the old black dotted line. This new green dashed line is used in place of the black dotted line as it improves clarity where vegetation boundaries and paths/tracks are close together.

The new symbol for Out of Bounds is also present – a purple cross hatch replacing the purple vertical lines.

Special symbols used are:

X (black) for a Seat or Picnic Table. Please note Picnic Tables are prone to being moved around and, although the map has been recently updated, some may have been shifted since.

O (black) for a Stick Hide – like a tepee.

Small blue square outline is used for a Water Trough, both metal and plastic.

All lone trees and bushes as well as small thickets are represented by a green dot.

Crossing points are marked. These are optional.
