Starts: 19:00 – 20:00 (later time than usual)

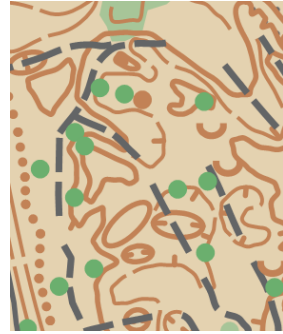
Courses Close: 21:00

Terrain: Sand Dunes

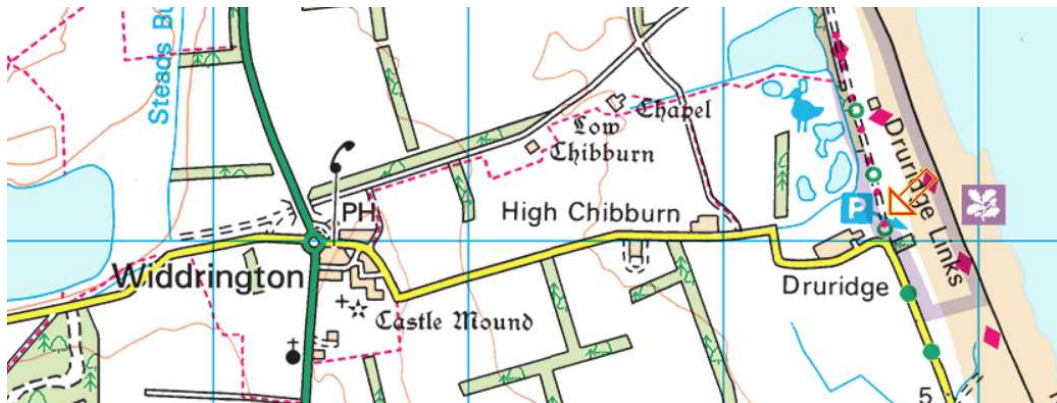
Courses: Short ~2km, Long ~3.5km

Map: 1:5000, Contours: 2.5m. This is not the Druridge Bay Country Park map.

Travel: Take the A1068 to Widdrington. Head east at the roundabout, signposted Druridge. Head down the road for approximately 2km. After the hamlet of Druridge where the road bends around to the right, turn left (north), and the parking is 100m further on.



Additional Information: Whistle mandatory. Spare head torch advised. The weather can be unpredictable so be prepared to carry/wear waterproofs, hat and gloves. Please leave emergency contact details at registration. If you think you will take a long time please start early!
